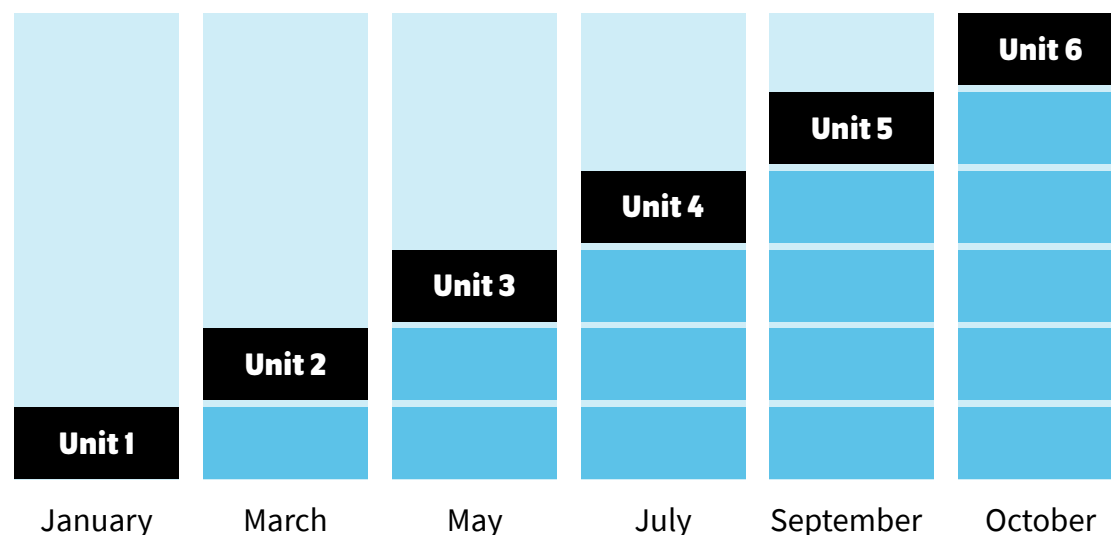

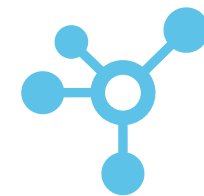

Current registration as a Registered Nurse (Division 1) with the Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency (AHPRA).

### OR;

Applicants without an AQF 7 bachelor degree in nursing (or equivalent qualification) who hold current registration as a Registered Nurse (Division 1) with the Australian Practitioner Regulation Agency (APHRA) will be considered for the Graduate Certificate in Nursing. Upon successful completion of the Graduate Certificate, applicants will be eligible for admission to Master of Nursing with credit.

### AND;

Current registration as a Registered Nurse (Division 1) with the Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency (AHPRA).

## FEE-HELP

You may be eligible for the Australian Government's loan scheme, FEE-HELP. The loans are available to assist eligible full-fee paying students with the cost of a university program. It can be used for all or part of the tuition. To determine your eligibility, visit the FEE-HELP website.

## Advanced standing

Thinking of applying for credit (advanced standing)? Advanced standing is an assessment process used to recognise the skills and knowledge you have acquired, either through study or life/work experience, by matching it with the content of units within your course. If you've already completed any of the units in the course in which you are enrolling, or their equivalent, you may be eligible for advanced standing.

## Exit option

Students have the option to exit with a Graduate Diploma in Nursing (8 units) if they choose not to complete the full master's degree.

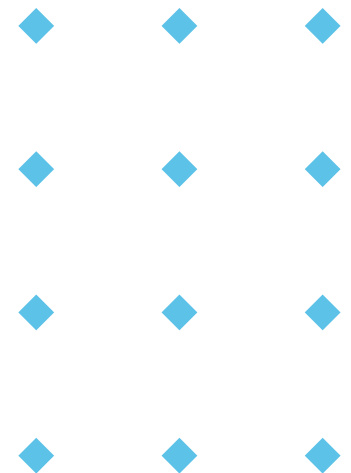
